It's no news that as believers, we're commissioned for greater works. Jesus made that very clear during His earthly ministry. Let's read what it says:

John 14:12:

Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and **GREATER WORKS** than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

But while we may be commissioned or destined for greater works, it's important that we also settle this truth in our mind. As a man thinks in his heart, so is he. God may have scheduled us for greater works, but none of us would do greater than we've done if we're unwilling to have a paradigm shift.

While God may declare His agenda, our duty is to believe Him - even if we don't understand it. And believing starts from our mind.

One of the greatest things I heard during Shiloh 2019 is that "I may not understand everything that God tells me, but it shouldn't stop me from believing and acting based on what He has said". God's thoughts are higher than mine; if I have to wait till I understand everything God says, I may never receive the expected returns.

For instance, the just shall live by his faith, not by his resources. This means that inadequacy of resources should not be the reason why you can't take progressive steps. There are many people who won't further their education because "they can't afford the fees". That should not be the case for a believer. If the just shall live by faith, it means you can further your education with faith. Faith can pay for all the fees money can pay for, you just need to learn the faith that works. If you can change your mindset, then nothing should stop you from furthering your education.

Many young people have continued to postpone their marriage all because they think they don't have enough resources to fund the wedding. Guess what? Enough money is never enough for marriage.

Stagnation and delay is essentially a mindset issue. The bible didn't consider your resources when it said the path of the just is progressive. If it was God who spoke, then consider it workable, you just have to walk in faith to see the result.

I'd be showing you keys that will empower you to do greater works. However, in order for you to have a full grasp of what GREATER WORKS means, let's see the extent to which Jesus worked during His earthly ministry.

- JESUS TURNED WATER TO WINE

The waiters reported a limitation to Mary who was more like the planner of the wedding at Cana. Wine had finished, and even if they had the raw materials needed to Greater Works

reproduce wine, they didn't have the luxury of time.

Hey, have you ever made wine? I did a little research on how to make homemade wine, and you'd be amazed at how much time and attention it requires.

Winemaking at home requires several pieces of equipment, serious cleanliness, and a lot of patience. The waiting is the hardest part.

Let's do an Equipment Checklist:

- One 4-gallon food-grade-quality plastic bucket and lid to serve as the primary fermentation vat
- Three 1-gallon glass jugs to use as secondary fermentation containers

- A funnel that fits into the mouth of the glass bottles
- Three airlocks (fermentation traps)
- A rubber cork (or bung) to fit into the secondary fermentation container
- Large straining bag of nylon mesh
- ❖ About 6 feet of clear half-inch plastic tubing
- About 20 wine bottles (you'll need 5 bottles per gallon of wine)
- Number 9-size, pre-sanitized corks
- Hand corker (ask about renting these from the wine supply store)
- A Hydrometer to measure sugar levels

Please tell me, which of these equipment did Jesus use to convert water to wine?

Now let's do an Ingredient Checklist:

- Lots and lots of wine grapes
- Granulated sugar
- Filtered water
- Wine yeast
- Campden tablets to help prevent oxidation, yeast nutrients, enzymes, tannins, acids.

Tell me again, what did Jesus use to prevent yeast nutrients, enzymes, tannins and acids? Who filtered the water He used? Where was the grape? Also bear in mind that maintaining these checklists doesn't guarantee that you'd have a good wine.

Now that's just the checklist, the process of making the wine itself is in 3 different parts.

PART ONE

- ❖ Ensure your equipment is thoroughly sterilized and then rinsed clean. (Ask at the wine supply store about special detergents, bleaches, etc.). It's best to clean and rinse your equipment immediately before using.
- Select your grapes, tossing out rotten or peculiar-looking grapes.
- ❖ Wash your grapes thoroughly.
- * Remove the stems.
- Crush the grapes to release the juice (called "must") into the primary fermentation container. Your hands will work here as well as anything. Or go old

school and stomp with your feet. If you're making a lot of wine, you might look into renting a fruit press from a wine supply store.

- ❖ Add wine yeast.
- ❖ Insert the hydrometer into the must. If it reads less than 1.010, consider adding sugar. If you're adding sugar, first dissolve granulated sugar in pure filtered water (adding sugar helps boost low alcohol levels). Stir the must thoroughly.
- Cover primary fermentation bucket with cloth; allow must to ferment for one week to 10 days. Over the course of days, fermentation will cause a froth to develop on top and sediment to fall to the bottom.

Ready for part two?

PART TWO

- Gently strain the liquid to remove the sediment and froth.
- Run the juice through a funnel into sanitized glass secondary fermentation containers. Fill to the top to reduce the amount of air reaching the wine.
- Fit the containers with airlocks.
- Allow the juice to ferment for several weeks.
- ❖ Use the plastic tube to siphon the wine into clean glass secondary fermentation containers. Again, the purpose here is to separate the wine from sediment that forms as the wine ferments.

Continue to siphon the wine off the sediment periodically (this is called "racking") for 2 or 3 months until the wine is running clear.

PART THREE

- Run the wine into bottles (using the cleaned plastic tubing), leaving space for the cork plus about a half inch or so of extra room.
- ❖ Insert corks.
- Store the wine upright for the first three days.
- ❖ After three days, store the wine on its side at, ideally, 55 degrees F. For red wine, age for at least 1 year. White wine can be ready to drink after only 6 months.

Please tell me, how many days did Jesus take to turn bowls of water into wine?

Sometimes we just read about these miracles but do nothing about the backgrounds. Something that should take 6 months to one year to get ready only took minutes for Jesus to do. The wine has to go through a process of fermentation as we've seen, and each of those processes take weeks to perfect. If the chairman of the wedding was a critic, he would have given a very unpalatable remark about that wedding.

But here's the good news; every other mundane method may take time, but not faith. Faith mixes and gets things ready now. It's important that we understand that what Jesus did at that wedding was totally impossible to a natural man. Isn't it amazing that the first work that Jesus did was "impossible"? Now think about it, if Jesus's works were impossible, what will greater works be like?

Don't think too far, the answer isn't far from "impossible". The idea behind greater works is "doing the works that Jesus did and continuing in the works".

Don't get me wrong, greater works doesn't necessarily mean healing the sick or turning water to wine like Jesus did; Philippians 4:8 gives a lucid explanation to this. Let's read what it says;

"Whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report ... think on these things." Philippians 4:8

So if what you want to do will bring good report, do it - the raging obstacles notwithstanding. Furthering your education will bring good report, and even though it may seem humanly impossible to go to school in your family, you've been mandated by God to make progress. It's impossible to get wine ready in one day, but Jesus broke that limit. To do greater works, you must be ready to break limits.

- JESUS FED 5000 PEOPLE AND MORE...

It's okay to do normal things, but our destiny as believers is to do abnormal things. The normal thing to do was to discharge those people so they could find a way to feed, but Jesus thought differently. It was impossible to feed 5000 people with just 5 loaves of bread and 2 fishes, but Jesus thought differently. If you want to do greater works, then you must be ready to think differently.

A miracle is birth when you spiritualize the logical reasons that deter your access to blessings. Jesus spiritualized the 3 loaves and 2 fishes, and what was logically insufficient became physically more than enough. Don't let the logic deceive you, spiritualize it.

- JESUS CURSED THE FIG TREE

Many people suffer only because they don't know their rights. Whatever causes you unnecessary pain is entitled to a curse. Jesus approached that tree believing that He'd find fruit to eat. To His amazement, there was none. He cursed the tree - never to bear fruit again.

That's what you should do to things that trouble you. If you don't curse them now, they'd persist. When they passed the tree the next day, the disciples confirmed that the tree had dried up. Guess what? It was never heard that Jesus approached a tree that didn't have fruit again, and that's because Jesus addressed it the first time.

A lady was going for a professional exam but was held back in traffic. By the time she got to

the testing centre, the exam had been canceled - because she got there late. The huge sum she paid had to be forfeited. That's a fig tree-like situation, and the agents that caused that delay are entitled to a curse. If you watch such a thing pass, you may not even make it to the testing centre the next time. Bishop David Oyedepo would often say "what you don't want you don't watch".

You don't keep quiet over issues that endanger your destiny. If you notice a virus or a bacterium in your body, curse it - never to arise in your body again. If a particular habit is oppressing your job, curse it. What you don't want, you don't watch!

- JESUS ROSE LAZARUS BACK TO LIFE

With God, whether you are full fleshed or just bones in the grave, you can still be considered as living. Lazarus was sick, died and was buried. Yet, while he was sick, Jesus said his sickness wasn't unto death. So the fact that Lazarus had been buried for four days and was already stinking didn't make any difference.

Your advancement or progress cannot be a forgotten issue. Failure is not fatal; the bible says the just man may fall 7 times but still would rise again. So no matter how many times and how hard you've fallen, God has made provision for you to rise again. So, RISE!

Like Ezekiel, speak God's word into every dry situation, and raise an army out of them. Your testimony must be shared!

LET'S BRING THIS TO OUR UNDERSTANDING

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO DO GREATER WORKS?

Number 1

IT MEANS INCREASING YOUR CAPACITY TO CREATE MORE VALUES

You can't be offering the same value and expect greater impact. If you want to increase impact, increase value. And you can't increase value without increasing capacity.

For over 7 months I was struggling with the limit that Facebook placed over user profiles. I had reached 5000 friends and it seemed like I had to delete inactive friends to add new ones. After a while I noticed that the responses I was getting on my profile dropped greatly. For instance, I used to have over 100 "Likes" on Timely Notes devotionals, but it came to a time when I couldn't boast of

20 "Likes". Yes! I couldn't figure out what the 5000 friends were doing.

It's amazing how people suddenly begin to devalue the things they used to consider valuable. This usually occurs when the value adder doesn't increase his or her capacity.

So God led me to create a Facebook Page, and instead of posting my Devotionals alone, I upped my capacity by posting video excerpts of most of my mentors. And in less than 7 months, the page had grown to over 130,000 followers. Guess what? The responses to Timely Notes Devotional also dramatically increased.

One way to increase capacity is to increase in knowledge. The more knowledgeable you are,

the more capacity you'd have to propagate more values. Just imagine what would have happened if I didn't know how to do video excerpts. Asides that, it's not just about the excerpts, but about the creativity that's being added to it.

Knowledge is fast! If you need to increase the speed of your accomplishments, just increase the rate at which you acquire knowledge. Knowledge is the only thing that has every other thing.

In 2 Chro 1:8-12, Solomon asked God for wisdom and knowledge to lead the Israelites properly; and surprisingly, God literally told him that it was impossible for knowledge not to be accompanied with wealth, possessions, and honor.

Knowledge is never alone; that is why people with good knowledge always feel heavily guarded. No wonder Elisha told his servant not to worry because "they that are with us are more than they that are with them". Knowledge makes you more than any opposition.

Knowledge has the secret to everything that pertains to life and godliness; that is what 2 Pet 1:3 tells us. Bishop David Oyedepo has often told us how he went up to the mountain to study about the secret to Kingdom prosperity; and when he found it, he screamed "I can never be poor". And truly, everyone who knows him also knows that he can never be poor.

Prov 24:14 says, "So shall the knowledge of wisdom be unto your soul, and when you have found it, there shall be a reward, and your expectations shall not be cut off". Everything you expect to have in life is in knowledge, you just need to find it.

Life is in phases; men are in sizes. Knowledge is what determines the size of every man.

If you want to change your ill look, then read books. One difference between the poor and the rich is that while the poor complains and blames the economy for his predicaments, the rich hunts for knowledge that will bail him out of his predicament. Life is like a hunting ground, man is the hunter, and knowledge is the prey. A prey is not something you easily catch; and that's why acquiring knowledge is

not easy. However, if you want to live, then you must catch knowledge.

No matter how dry a forest or bush may seem, a committed hunter will still go home with something. No matter the depth of famine or recession a nation may be going through, knowledge will always make a difference. Knowledge may not immediately resolve the challenge at hand, but it would certainly give you a chance to move ahead. When things get out of hand, knowledge gives you a new hand. Knowledge won't let you go if you would let it show. Challenges may hang around, but only till you show them knowledge.

Knowledge shows; that's why the bible says we should "study to show ourselves

approved". If what you know is not showing, then you need to know more.

Get educated! The most referred characters in scriptures were people who were not only educated, but well-informed about doctrines of their nations. Moses was educated, and he knew secret things about Egypt. Daniel was educated, even to a point that God had to give him additional wisdom and knowledge. His relevance could not be overlooked; he remained a royal counsellor over many kingdoms. Paul was educated under Gamaliel, strictly according to the law of his fathers. Jesus was a carpenter's son, but Luke 4:16 tells us that His custom was to read. The sons of Issachar were people who understood the times and knew what Israel should do.

I'm not sure how much God will use you without education. Of course, God can do anything, but even the bible tells us that the excellency of knowledge is that it gives life to them that have it. This could also mean that the kind of life that knowledge will give you cannot be compared to any other kind of life. God wasn't joking when He said "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge". It's just unfortunate that many believers have taken their faith in God to be a substitute for acquiring knowledge. The truth is, faith comes, not just by hearing the word of God, also by hearing other relevant but information by the word of God.

If it ever gets to a time when your thoughts stop giving expression, and your prayers stop bringing utterance, then there's something you need to know. Knowledge is like food to the body, and your life places a very high demand for it. Thinking and praying can be likened to breathing; and if you stop feeding, it won't be long before you stop breathing. The devil knows that God is able to do whatever we ask or think. He also knows that we can't ask or think right without appropriate knowledge. And that's why he'd do anything to block our access to true knowledge.

Many Christians lose their prayer and thinking life because they're starving in knowledge. The moment you lose your prayer and thinking life, it won't be long before you fall into temptation. Remember the bible says we should "watch and pray, lest we'd fall into temptation". In other words, "think and pray, otherwise you'd fall into temptation". In my opinion, before you think of what to eat, first

think of what to read. It is said that "a man who does not work should not eat"; but I'd like to add that "a man who has not read should also not eat".

KNOWLEDGE IS POWER. WE PRAY AND THINK ON IT. ONCE KNOWLEDGE IS DISPLACED, IGNORANCE BECOMES THE TRUTH.

Number 2

IT MEANS TAKING RESPONSIBILITY TO CREATE A BETTER LIFE

2 Pet 1:3 tells us that God has given us all things that pertains to life and godliness through the knowledge of Christ. In other words, take a moment to think of a deserving life, whatever you decide, God has given you all it takes to live that life.

If your desire is to go through school, get a job, get married, own a few cars, a few businesses, travel frequently, become royalty, all these are no big deal with God, you just need to take responsibility in searching for the relevant knowledge that gives such a life.

We live in a time and age where the average believer wishes that God would just do a quick miracle or design another garden of Eden and put them inside like He did for Adam. Well guess what? Miracles are not mere accidents; they are deliberate acts of God that are provoked by the desperate acts of men. And nobody "acts" without knowledge; even a mad man knows what he's doing.

Number 3

IT MEANS MMOVING FROM WHAT MAY SEEM LIKE A COMFORT ZONE TO A DESTINED ZONE

It's important to understand that the destiny of every believer is to emerge as giants in various fields and industries - thereby drawing nations and kingdoms to Him. Obadiah 1:21 says, "And saviours shall come up on mount Zion to judge the mount of Esau; and the kingdom shall be the LORD's".

No matter where you are today, God expects your impact to be palpable. Isaiah 60:22 says "A little one shall become a thousand, and a small one a strong nation". In other words, if you claim to be a giant, your sphere of



influence shouldn't contain less than a thousand people.

The question is, how many people is your life impacting? If it's less than a thousand, then you have greater works ahead of you.

QUICKLY, LET ME SHOW YOU TWO FORCES THAT WILL EMPOWER YOU TO DO GREATER WORKS.

Number 1

THE HOLY SPIRIT

At age 13, Jesus was already teaching comfortably. He could teach and PhD holders would listen and even ask questions. But it's amazing that nothing was said about Him again for 17 years. And this was someone who was destined to be the Saviour of the world. But when the Holy Spirit came upon Him, we were told that His fame went abroad.

Matters of destiny are not handled by skill alone; they're handled by the Spirit. And that's why if the Holy Spirit doesn't help you, you can't actualize destiny.

Peter's destiny was to be an apostle of Jesus, yet he couldn't even defend the same Jesus before a little girl. But when the Holy Spirit came upon him, he spoke to a crowd about the same Jesus and over 3000 people were added to the church.

When they told the disciples to stop teaching in the name of Jesus, all they had to do was to receive power from the Holy Spirit. So if it feels like you're being stopped from fulfilling destiny, ask the Holy Spirit to help you.

Number 2

FAITH

Moses had a desire to give the people of Israel a better life. He had a comfortable life in Pharaoh's palace, but it seemed he desired a destiny life. Out of his altruistic desire, he murdered an Egyptian army who was oppressing some Israelite, but because he didn't have faith to defend his actions, he became a runaway. Yes, he ran away for his dear life.

Just imagine, someone who was destined to free Israel from servitude fled when the opportunity arose. The truth is, when it comes to matters of destiny, desire alone cannot help you, you need faith. What is faith? It's a display of confidence in God and His word until your desired result is obtained. Hebrews 10:35-36 makes this clear. Let's read what it says;

Hebrews 10:

35 Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward.

36 For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

Verse 35 clearly explains that your faith would certainly be rewarded with your expectation if you won't cast away your confidence in God. People have often asked me how they'd know when their faith has worked, I don't hesitate to tell them that it's

when they've seen the manifestation of their expectation. That may sound bitter, but it's true. Faith is not a passive force like many people have preached it, faith is an active force; you act on it till you see what you expect.

So Moses remained in the wilderness for many years until he finally encountered faith to go back to Egypt to fulfil his desire. He received a word from God, and believing and acting on a word received from God is what we call faith.

But here's where many believers miss out; they conclude that God failed them the moment the word they believed in didn't get the expected result. Moses understood better, each time Pharaoh declined the instructions he gave to him, he simply went back to God for another word. Many believers don't go back to God, they sit back expressing regret and defeat.

Moses' experience taught us that it's possible for the first and even the seventh word you've received from God to be declined by the opposition. The fight of faith is a fight of words and actions. Don't expect the devil to just quit because you spoke one scripture to him. Even Jesus, the Word personified, was tried 3 times, and each of those times He spoke a different word.

If you're trusting God for a miracle job for instance, search the scriptures for a word that guarantees that you'd have one. After you must have applied it - whether through

prayer or obedience and it doesn't seem to yield the expected result, get back to the scriptures and find another word. That's what verse 36 implies; it says, "you have need of patience, because you'd only receive your expectation after you've completed the will of God (paraphrased)".

When it comes to faith, God's will is more important than your need. Moses needed to free Israel from Egypt, but God's will or desire was to show Pharaoh how mighty He can be. So each time Moses plagued Pharoah and Egypt, God would yet harden Pharaoh's heart to decline. And when Moses went back to God to express his concern, God would tell him that He wasn't done with His will yet.

But hey, there's always one last plague to release upon Pharaoh, and after that he'd let

you go. There's always one last scripture to discover about your job. There's always one last scripture to discover about your marital destiny. There's always one last scripture to discover about your business breakthrough. Prov 24:14 says, "So shall the knowledge of wisdom be unto thy soul: when thou hast found it, then there shall be a reward, and thy expectation shall not be cut off". There's always a word that would crown all your efforts in faith, you just have to keep searching till you find it.

The thing about this kind of faith is that every word you find would feel like the word that would resolve the challenge or give you your expectation. And yes, it really does, except that each of them only lightens the situation. Like they say, it's not the tenth strike on the rock that broke the rock, it's the joint effort of

the other 9 strikes. So, keep striking till it breaks. Moses kept striking till Pharaoh gave up.

Here's something else we should consider about faith; when our faith doesn't work, we shouldn't blame God for it. From what we've learnt so far, it's clear that God is never to be blamed for the inefficiency of our faith. We're not serving God because He'd meet our need, we're serving Him because He's God, and whether He meets our needs or not, He's still God.

I lost my job in 2015 and had to struggle for 7 months before I could get another one. It was during that period that I learnt the active nature of faith. I began 2016 with a 21-day

fasting and prayer, and getting another job took top priority on my list.

Despite the tenacity I applied in fasting and praying, one would think that God would open up the heavens and give me another job, but no, I had to find a word for every moment. One of the first things that God told me to do was to change my zonal centre to a place where I'd be able to assist the pastor in charge. After a month, He told me to go to a bible school and render services to them with my IT skills. And while I was there, He gave me several other instructions; while some of those instructions led me to my prayer altar, most of them were instructions that needed to be obeyed.

remember after obeying one of His instructions, someone walked up to me and told me that he'd like to give me a job. To me, it was a miracle because I never mentioned it to him. But guess what? He never gave me that job. Someone else would have gotten angry at God for the "disappointment", but not me, I understood better. I went back to God and asked Him what was next. I continued in obedience until the time that my breakthrough came. When it came, it was obvious that it was God who orchestrated it, because I never applied for a job in that place.

Few months after I resumed work there, God opened me up to business opportunities. A year after, I authored 27 e-books. My life has experienced dramatic transformations since then. I've seen Christians who enter into similar challenges but remain jobless for

years. And it's mostly because they handle the subject of faith passively. Never forget, faith is not a passive force, it's an active force.
