JUST BEFORE WE BEGIN...

If God should transfer the role of convicting sinners from the Holy Spirit to Believers, many people would prefer to remain unbelievers.

Christianity should be attractive. But even though the bible qualifies us to be the joy of many generations, many believers seem to be the reason for many people's alienation. Prayer is good; but I sometimes feel that praying over certain issues is a sign of irresponsibility on our part. It's amazing how many believers have become lazy about things they did easily while they were in the world. Did Christianity make them lazy?

Many of them even use "grace" as an umbrella. These days, when a neighbour or friend does better than a believer, his conclusion is "grace". As much as God loves the fact that we reverence His power, He doesn't want us to think like mediocres.

I've analyzed these things and I've come to a conclusion that the reason why many believers are not getting results is because they are not properly scripted, they are ***unscripted!***

In this book, I've outlined 7 keys that will transform any believer from an unscripted life to a fully scripted life. Have a good read!

Key Number One

HAVE AN ENCOUNTER WITH JESUS

I don't just mean "giving your life to Jesus", I mean having a real conviction that Jesus is Lord. It's one thing to give your life to Jesus, and it's another thing to know that Jesus has accepted to be your Lord and Saviour. There are many people who receive Jesus today and denounce Him in the face of torment tomorrow. All because they lack conviction.

Yeah, I know the biblical signs that you'd see that proves you're born again, but do you have an experience that gives a name to your Christian life. Today, God has many names, including the ones that are associated to His experiences with people. We hear names like

"The God of Abraham", "The God of Jacob", "The God of Isaac". He even associated His name to a nation, "The Holy One of Israel". In other words, no matter how much Israel sins, He continually stands as their holiness. And this is why they'd always prosper.

What is God to you? Can a dimension of God be captured in your Christian experience? Can somebody pray - trusting the "God of Emeka Anslem" to deliver him? All those people that attributed their names to God's name had personal experiences with God, why do I have to keep calling the God of Abraham when I can also have the God of my Christian experiences. What is your experience with God?

Moses had an experience with God in the burning bush, and that encounter helped him

fulfill destiny. Jacob wrestled with an angel, and that experience transformed him into a nation. The experiences they've had with God has been a source of motivation for believers today. When will your experience or encounter with Jesus begin to motivate others too? I know how many writers who only started writing when they heard that God empowered me to write 27 books in one year.

Some people are doing well in life only because of the experiences that their mother had with God. They know they should suffer considering their careless approach to life; but on the contrary, every little effort they make expand their lives. It's not about them, it's the God of their mother. Elisha would not have been able to pass that Jordan if not for the God of Elijah that he engaged. He remembered Elijah's association with God

and he came to a conclusion that the God of Elijah could path that river.

You need to have an encounter with God. That's where your conviction for a successful Christian life begins. Bishop David Oyedepo had an encounter with God concerning wealth, and he came to a conclusion that he can never be poor. An encounter with God will create the staying power you need to breakthrough in life.

Key Number Two

BE GENUINELY BAPTIZED IN THE HOLY GHOST

The Holy Spirit is not just a spiritual representation of Christ; He also enables us to do whatever Jesus would do.

When Jesus was preparing to ascend to heaven, He mentioned that He'd send another comforter. In other words, He acted as a comforter while He was with them. If we think about it, His disciples were really comfortable throughout His ministry. Nothing was impossible to them; and even when they encountered challenges that appeared to be too difficult to them, they just referred the case to Jesus.

They were able to feed over 5000 people, because Jesus was there. The sick were healed and the dead came back to life, because Jesus was there. Water turned to wine, because Jesus was there. The storm could not drown their boat, because Jesus was there. They always had money, because Jesus was there. Jesus was comfort to them.

But things changed after Jesus was captured. All His disciples went into hiding. The man who comforted them had been captured. Peter who vowed that he won't deny Jesus denied Jesus three times, even before a little girl.

After they received the Holy Spirit, Peter who could not witness Jesus before a little girl could now speak to thousands of people at once. His shadow and clothes now healed the

sick and even raised the dead. Those were things that only Jesus could do. The Holy Spirit comes into us to enable us do things that only Jesus would do.

One of the pathing words of Jesus was "He that believes in me, the works that I do shall he do also, and greater works shall He do, because I go to My Father". He said that because He knew He was sending a spiritual representation of Himself, and as long as His Spirit is within man, there's no limit to what can be achieved.

Imagine Jesus running away from His landlord or struggling to pay His rent. Imagine Jesus failing an exam and having to repeat a course. Whatever you can't imagine happen to Jesus should not be seen around you when you're baptized in the Holy Spirit.

This is why you genuinely need to be baptized. And in case you're not, please chat with me directly after this conference.

Key Number Three

BE COMMITTED TO STUDYING GOD'S WORD AND OTHER BOOKS

This is essential if you want to attract helpers and favours into your life.

Stop complaining that "customers are not coming", or "people are not giving you favours"; the bible says "Gentiles shall come to your light". In other words, if you don't have light, they won't come. People are naturally activated to move where and when there's light.

Even God could not commence creation until He first created light. Value was added to the earth when light was created. You can't truly

have light and not attract favourers; favourers daily look for where there is light. If you want people to help you, then create light!

It's the entrance of the word that gives light. The more of God's word you understand, the better you shine. And the more you shine, the more favours you attract. The bible says, "The path of the Just is as a shining light that shines brighter and brighter unto the perfect day".

The perfect day is when you no longer have to struggle to get things done; but before you get there, you have to consciously develop your light to shine brighter and brighter. Our light won't get brighter on its own, we have to take responsibility to brighten it. And we do that by studying, meditating, and acting on the word of God.

Study to show yourself approved. If people don't approve to help you, then you've not studied enough; because the moment you show yourself approved, you'd immediately get the help you need.

KNOWLEDGE COVERS PAIN...

Knowledge covers pain. Isaiah 11:9 tells us that "it shall come to pass that destruction shall cease because the knowledge of the Lord shall fill the earth as the waters covers the sea". If it ever feels like challenges are covering you, then cover them with the knowledge of the Lord. The bible tells us that the name of Jesus is a strong tower, and the righteous runs under it for safety. And Rev 19:13 further tells us that His name was called the word of God. In other words, if His name covers people from trouble, then His word also covers people from trouble.

I once paid my cousin a visit. And when we met, she told me she couldn't go out because she had "runny nose". Coincidentally, I also had runny nose. But when I told her, she said mine was not serious because it was not showing. I didn't hesitate to tell her that "Knowledge has covered it". Knowledge has a way of making situations beautiful. Certain situations may not go, but knowledge can make them beautiful to live with. Somebody once asked Bishop David Oyedepo if he ever has problems; he responded saying "maybe it came and I didn't know". That's how beautiful knowledge can make situations.

The path of the righteous is as a shining light; and knowledge makes it better and better, until it becomes perfect.

Key Number Four

DON'T ONLY GET A JOB, TURN YOUR PASSION INTO A BUSINESS, AND MAKE MONEY!

Before money was invented, people would exchange their services or barter with each other. This meant the more you did for others, the more favours you stacked up, so that if you needed something done you could call in the favour. But today it is money that stacks up in our bank account, not favours. Simply put, the more money you have, the more people you have helped! This means that those without enough money have not yet found an effective way of helping lots of people.

One of the most effective ways of helping more people is mastering the business of your talent or passion. There is something you love to do that many people are willing to pay for. For instance, I naturally love teaching and writing, but you'd be amazed how much I get paid to write a book on behalf of someone. Some times it runs into hundreds of thousands. While I do the job I'm employed to do, I also profit from my passion.

Asides writing, I also cook. Today, I run a home chef service. Don't just stay passionate, profit from your passion.

This is the 21st century, you need to have more than one stream of income to survive. You need all the money you can get. If you don't have money, it will take the grace of God for unbelievers to hear you. The

presence of money will not only help you preach salvation, it will also make you the salvation. You can't imagine how many old men who are old enough to be my father call me "Baba". Put Christianity aside, money creates a sense of superiority. You can't preach about God effectively when you've not become a god over money.

You need money!

Key Number Five

BE DILIGENT

Diligence upgrades your association.

If you cannot find a job with what you know, then train people with what you know till it becomes a job. It is upsetting to see highly skilled individuals sit at home all in the name of "no employment".

As a skilled sports person, do not wait till an international club finds you; rather, find young people who are also interested in your kind of sport and train them. Training is actually the most paying job today. Asides sports, this principle applies to every field of endeavor.

As a young writer, training other writers has fetched me some money. And presently, we run a documentation company called "In-

spirited Writers Consult". My writing skill could not get me a salary job, but diligence has produced a company from it.

There is a difference between "work" and "a job". A job puts you on a payroll, while work may not necessarily guarantee immediate or scheduled financial returns. Yet, it is your work that creates opportunity for a job. If you stop working, then it will not be long before you lose your job.

It is the works of our hand that God blesses. So, let us work with our various skills - even if it has to be a volunteer service. I have written for free for many years, but now, I get paid to write. Work will ultimately provide a job for you; but a job without a mind to work has no future.

Key Number Six
BE A GIVER

The bible didn't say "A Christian that gives to the poor shall not lack"; rather, it says "He that gives to the poor shall not lack". While most of God's laws applies to believers, there are some of His laws that applies to everyone, including unbelievers.

For instance, Ecc 9:11 says "Time and chance happens to all". In other words, every man will definitely get a time or an opportunity to prove himself. Gen 8:22 says "While the earth remains, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease". Just as night and day affects everyone, the law of giving and receiving works for everyone, including unbelievers.

Many believers have wondered why most renown organizations and government

sectors are run by unbelievers; the answer is not so far from those scriptures, they maximized their chance and they submit to the law of giving and receiving.

It's amazing how unbelievers practice giving more than those who sit down to confess God's word on a daily basis. God will prefer to put an unbeliever in power as long as certain people's need will continue to be met, rather than putting a believer who does not have a giving heart or who does not know how to maximize opportunities.

Jesus may be interceding for us in heaven, but their giving and diligence is also interceding for them. That's why no matter how much you curse a giver, he'd still be increasing. This war is tougher than we think; taking over the world must begin by taking over our hearts.

When opportunities come, will you make the most of it? When someone around you needs help, will you do all you can to help him? Remember that time and chance happens to us all.

FORMULA FOR WEALTH

It's painful to love God and still suffer challenges. Wealth is a state of sufficiency in all things, and abundance for every good works. Wealth isn't just measured by how much money you have, but also how much lives you've touched.

To enjoy financial prosperity, you must engage the principle in 2 Cor 9:8. It says "God is able to make all grace abound towards you, such that you'd have sufficiency in all things,

and abundance for every good works". In simpler terms, "God is ready to release blessings to you, but after you've taken what is sufficient for you, use the rest for good works". That also means that if you don't have a plan to give, then you can't receive as much as you expect. God doesn't expect us to keep more than we need. Prov 11:24 says "There is he that scattereth and yet increases, but there is he that withholds more than is sufficient for him, and he still tends to poverty".

This may be against everything you've learnt about financial intelligence, but let God be true and all men liars. Saving money is good; but just as you think of what to save monthly, also think of what to give monthly. The only way to increase in this kingdom is to be a selfless distributor of God's blessing. Those who take more than is sufficient for them are

simply on their way to poverty. But those who take what is sufficient and channel the rest to those who need them experiences increase. Don't let the devil deceive you into believing that you have to manage what you have, the widow of Zarephat still had to share her last meal with the prophet. And mysteriously, what was supposed to be her last meal fed her and her family all through the period of famine.

You don't come out of poverty by keeping what remains, but by giving from what remains. Every opportunity to give is an opportunity to receive.

Giving powers our supplications. While prayer may speak to God, our gifts speaks directly to men. The bible says "the gifts of a man makes room for him and brings him before great

men". Another scripture says "Give and it shall be given unto you, good measure, pressed down, shaking together, shall men bring unto your bosom.

I recently prayed that the Holy Spirit should sit on me until my breakthrough in business is established. I've been a writer since 2012, with over 30 eBooks written. Being confident of my track record in writing, I decided to venture into the business of ghost writing - someone who writes on behalf of someone else. I've had clients over the years, but I wanted big shots this time. And that was what compelled me to make that supplication to God.

Just a day after I made that prayer, I was compelled to buy food for one of my pastors who had been working all day. To my

surprise, he was grateful and ate the food without delay. A few minutes after, he sent for me and asked if I do ghost writing, that he has some thoughts he'd like to put together into a book. Trust me, that's big shot!

Why would the Holy Spirit compel me to give something to him? He had known me for years, how come it never occurred to him to hire my service? The answer is simple; the gift of a man makes room for him. Don't ever mistake supplication for giving, neither should you ever allow supplication take the place of giving.

The bible says "if you want to go and visit a wicked man, go with a gift". But I've come to discover that this does not only apply to wicked men, it also applies to good men. When you give something to a man, whether

a good man or a bad man, his heart will not rest until he compensates your kind gesture. Sometimes what you give me not necessarily be money, it may be favour, opportunity, counsel, relief, just be sensitive enough to know what to give, and you'd be amazed at what these people will give back in return. I once helped a political leader to secure audience with my father Bishop David Oyedepo, and I believe he must have been thinking of what to do for me. One day, he sent me a chat with a surprising question, "Which political leader will you like to be a personal assistant to?". If my personality was different, maybe I'd be working with the government in an esteemed office today.

Key Number Seven

**BE PRAYERFUL, AND ACT
IN OBEDIENCE TO GOD'S
WORD**

Prayer is surprisingly listed among the last. But unfortunately, many Christians have built a house around this. They make prayer an excuse to be lazy. They pray about things they should work out. This is why the bible considers the children of the world to be wiser than the children of the kingdom. Prayer should start the work, not do the work. After you've prayed, then start working.

However, prayer is a very powerful force. Though prayer may not totally change a situation, but it would definitely add beauty and color to it. Prayer may not prevent a woman from feeling the pain of labour, but it would give her the joy of being a mother. Prayer may not prevent us from writing our exams, but it would give us hope for success. Prayer may not prevent us from going for an

interview, but it would guarantee us a job. God makes all things beautiful when we pray to Him, including difficult situations.

Face your challenges with confidence in God. "Faith" is risking everything on God, and God will never fail those that trust in Him. Do what you have to do, especially when God has approved it. The process may be painful and difficult, but with God, you are sure to emerge victorious. Prayer could not prevent Jesus from dying for our sins, but it guaranteed Him victory at the end.

Prayer could not change the fact that Abraham needed to prove his loyalty to God by sacrificing Isaac. I perceive that there are many things we are praying for that may only require acting in obedience to God's word. Remember that prayer used to be the master

key to every situation until revelation changed the lock; obedience is the new key.

FINALLY...

The fight of faith is an exchange of words and actions. While the opposition may attack you with negative words and situations, you should also strike back with God's word and faith actions. You may feel the pain and hunger that the enemy is putting on you, but act like the blessed man that God has called you. In this kingdom, actions speak louder than words. The angels may not always respond when you speak, but their response is automated when they see your faith actions.

I remember praying for someone who left home and didn't return long after the expected time. While praying, I specifically

mentioned that the person must return in 30 minutes' time. After the prayer, I sat down with the family for 30 minutes, just to prove to God that I meant what I prayed. And miraculously, the person returned at exactly 30 minutes from the time we prayed.

God may often doubt your words, but He can't doubt your actions. He may judge you by your words, but He weighs all your actions. 1 Sam 2:3 says *"talk no more so very proudly, let not arrogance come from your mouth; for the LORD is a God of knowledge, and by him actions are weighed"*.

Sometimes, the words of our mouth may appear as pride and arrogance to god, but our faith actions can speak otherwise.
